Surtees. "Plain or Ringlets?" Ca. late 19<sup>th</sup> century. Cover stamped in gilt and black (some wear). Many hand-colored plates after John Leech. One of his humorous hunting novels. No jacket (not issued with one).

The Duke of Beaufort. Fox-Hunting. 1980.

Nimrod. My Horses and Other Essays. Edited by E.D. Comings. 1928. First book publication of his articles on hunting, etc. With b&w plates from the 19<sup>th</sup> century. No jacket. Nice bright copy.

Lionel Edwards. The Wiles of the Fox. 1932. Lightly foxed in some places. Many b&w ills. + color plates (white, black, red) or hunting scenes. No jacket.

Roger Longrigg. The History of Foxhunting. 1975. Many ills. Large, full of info. Chiefly Britain and the U.S.; also earlier history.

Lionel Edwards. A Leicestershire Sketch Book. 1935. One of his popular large "sketch book" series. Internally fine.

James L. Young. A field of Horses: The World of Marshall P. Hawkins. 1988. Foreword by Jacqueline Kennedy Onassis. The hunting, point-to-point, etc., photos of Hawkins.

Amy Rosi. The Pony Book: The World of Emerson Burr. Ex-library copy, in jacket. Tips from the legendary children's show pony trainer. 1986.

Cheryl M. Seaver and Laura J. Cunningham. The Good Mudder's Guide: A Manual for Horse Show Mothers. 1988. Real advice, with a sense of humor.

Lorna Howlett. Complete Book of Ponies. 1984. Comprehensive breed survey.

Anna Sewell. Black Beauty. 2000. An edition with many color ills., including period ills. of carriages, London street scenes, etc. Paperbound, as new. (Published at 17.99)

Gordon Wright. Learning to Ride, Hunt and Show. New ed. Ill. by Sam Savitt. 1966. A nostalgic favorite! This copy is a little worn, in jacket.

Vladimir Littauer. Jumping the Horse. Derrydale Press, 1931. One of 950 copies.

Edward Mayhew. The Illustrated Horse Management... No date, ca. 1870s-80s. Average copy in original binding (rebacked). Over 500 pp., many interesting line ills. A real Victorian period piece.

Michael Friedman. Cowboy Culture: The Last Frontier of American Antiques. 1992. 4-page value guide laid in (as of 1992!). Large book, many color photos. As new. Published at \$79.95

Will James. Cowboy in the Making. 1942. Early but not first edition, but a very nice copy in jacket.

J.N.P. Watson, ed. The World's Greatest Horse Stories. 1979. Adult's and children's.

Jack and Patricia Demuth. *City Horse*. 1979. Children's b&w photo book about training and using a real NYC police horse. Ex-library, with only one rubber stamp inside.

Walter Farley. *The Black Stallion Mystery*. 1957. Early but not first edition. In the original format, with worn jacket.

Enid Bagnold. "National Velvet" 1935. No Jacket. An early printing in the original format.

Monique and Hans D. Dossenbach. *The Nobel Horse*. 1998. Coffee-table picture and history survey.
